

The changes of subjective symptoms after 6 months treatment with four different pills

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Objectives: Authors followed for six months the changes of the subjective symptoms and the quantity of bleeding with four different pills treatment.

Methods: Authors analyzed the dates of 167 patients, within six months. The average age of the patients was between 17-26 years. Those patients were included into the study, who started the four different pills as a first pill, or have been changed from another one. The questions were: sexual activity, orgasm, pain, acne, bleeding, nausea, headache, vomiting and other rare serious side effects.

Results: In the first three months there were not significant changes in the sexual life and subjective symptoms, but from the 3rd month we have found significant changes in these field of life.

Conclusions: We think, that the changes are the results of taking pills.
